Procedures & Submission

Procedures:

The exam is open in nearly the broadest sense possible. You may use books, notes, problem solutions that I've posted, *etc.* However, you may *not* use the help of others, and you may *not* help others. This does mean that asking questions on Internet forums is also *not* allowed.

There will be a place on the exam asking you to sign to certify that you have both completed the work without help from anyone else and did not provide help to anyone else.

I have not designed the exam to take longer than the typical, 2.5-hour in-class final exam would. However, you may take all the time necessary to complete the exam within the approximate 16-hour window provided to you.

The exam will be posted to the class website as a PDF by 8:00am on Tuesday, May 5. It is due by 11:59pm on Tuesday, May 5. Work submitted after 11:59pm will receive a penalty at the rate of 10 points per half-hour.

Submission:
